The School of Opportunity is seeking multiple one-on-one aides to assist and supervise high-needs students in vocational, academic, social, leisure, self-help, communication, functional living, domestic and community skills training as designated on the students' IEPs. This position will assist under the guidance of the classroom instructor to prepare and maintain classroom, materials and equipment. Participate in parent conferences. Perform classroom duties as directed by intervention specialist.

Assist in documenting/disseminating student training, attendance, behavior and performance records and reports. Assist students with mobility, physical and clothing needs, behavior support strategies, positioning, feeding, toileting, basic therapeutic exercises, medical procedures, etc. under direction of designated specialist.

High School Diploma or equivalent required; must be able to obtain ODE Educational Aide Certificate. Must pass pre-employment drug screening and background check.
